

WHAT TO DO WHEN CITY OF BOSTON DECLARES A SNOW EMERGENCY

Reminded residents of the following:

- **Move cars from main arterials during snow emergencies. A listing of main arterials can be found at:**
www.cityofboston.gov/snow/parking.asp
- **Do not park cars within 20 feet of an intersection. Parking too close to an intersection can restrict emergency vehicle access.**
- **Do not throw snow back into the street. “Throwbacks” force the city to remove snow from the same street twice.**
- **Shovel out fire hydrants close to your home.**
- **Property owners are reminded to shovel snow from sidewalks that abut homes and businesses**
- **Do not double park.**
- **Keep wheelchair ramps clear.**
- **Check on elderly and neighbors and others in need.**

During declared snow emergencies, discounted parking is available at several parking lots and garages to cars that display Boston resident parking stickers. A list of locations is available at www.cityofboston.gov/snow.
